## Life Sharing through Family Living

Assists people with intellectual disabilities who desire to live with the support of a loving and caring family or companion in the community. Life Sharing is more than providing the basics such as food and shelter. It is about sharing life experiences, and building mutual relationships and responsibility.

Currently the Developmental Programs division provides Life Sharing Services to 59 individuals.

### *Services*

- Design and implementation of person-centered plans according to individual needs and desires
- Socialization via recreational, work, and community involvement
- Therapeutic and health care supports

### *Eligibility*

- Must be age 18 or older with an intellectual disability, meeting waiver eligibility requirements

### *Enrollment*

- All admissions referred through the Department of Human Services in Philadelphia and from the Offices of Mental Retardation throughout Southeastern Pennsylvania.

### *Cost*

Individuals pay 72% of their monthly income, not to exceed the maximum allowable from Supplemental Security Income [SSI]
